

LIMPOPO stand-up comedian and entertainer Mr Majo is rapidly building a fan base wherever he performs in the country. The funny man from Venda uses his sense of humour to heal trou-bled souls while also sending subtle messages of hope. Mr Majo is known for his mes-merising and captivating story-telling ability which comes with the funniest punch lines.

Born Mukovhe Peter Magwedze, he is the second-born son of Apos-tle Magwedze. He grew up in a family fond of laughter "and this humour was nurtured and increased by my love of stand-up comedy and TV sitcoms". Mr Majo enrolled for a BA in Film and TV Production at the Univer-sity of Cape Town in 2008. He started his career as a comedian when he was asked to be MC at a wedding after he was invited by a local pastor.

"After that I started writing my own material and have been per-forming in various places across the country ever since," he said. His performances saw him get-ting the title of "Almost Famous" from people who saw his potential. Mr Majo's energetic and hilarious sets are delivered in most South African languages. The bulk of his material is based on his family, childhood experiences, current affairs and his funny observation of the goings-on at local churches.
